6. AGE QUALIFICATIONS

Each team consists of 4 gymnasts ages 12-18.
Age category 1: born 2008/2009
Age category 2: born 2010/2011
Age category 3: born 2012 and later

7. DELEGATION

Each delegation consists of:
1 Coach
1 Judge
4 Gymnasts
Additional accompanying persons will be categorized as “other.”

8. JUDGES

All judges must have a current valid FIG license category 1/2/3 at the time of the event. Each team taking part in the competition must bring a judge. The fee for a missing judge is 600,00 €.



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9. GUIDELINES

Scoring will be according to the Junior Code of Points (Code de Pointage (C.d.P), Juniors) in its most current version. Rules for the youngest age category will be applied.

10. COMPETITION FORMAT

Team Competition:

Team 4 / 4 / 3 (at least 1 gymnast must belong to age category 1). All 4 gymnasts perform on all apparatuses. The three highest scores count for the final result.

Single gymnasts are not permitted.

Finals:

The best 6 gymnasts per apparatus and age category will qualify for the finals. Maximum of 1 gymnast per nation allowed per final. A wildcard is reserved for the hosting club. To qualify for the vault final, 2 different routines will have to be performed. Only for age category 3, may these routines belong to the same C.d.P group.

Live Stream:

A live stream may be provided, if possible. More details will be provided at a later time.

11. MEDALS AND AWARDS

- Certificate of participation for all gymnasts.
- Individual: the best 6 gymnasts per age category
- Team competition: the best 6 teams
- Apparatus finals: the best 3 gymnasts per age category

14. TRAVELING EXPENSES

Each delegation is responsible for all costs outside of the official competition. A free shuttle service to and from the airport will be provided on the planned arrival and departure days. If a cab service is necessary due to late arrival times, the receipt can be submitted to the organizer.

The Organizer will not be responsible for providing transportation for early arrivals or late departures. The shuttle-service is only reserved for delegations, who have sent us travel itineraries with the form “by names entry” by April 23, 2025.

16. CANCELLATION

Cancellations until May 30th, 2026 accrue no fees or penalties. Teams cancelling after the March 31th, 2026 deadline will be responsible for full payment.

17. FAREWELL DINNER

The farewell dinner will take place on Saturday evening at 8:00 p.m.

18. SIGHTSEEING TOUR

Interested persons are welcome to join a sightseeing tour on Saturday evening after the competition concludes. A separate fee will apply. Registration for this tour should be made at the technical meeting.

19. PAYMENTS

After the registration deadline, the delegations will receive an invoice from the organizer. Please transfer the full payment and be sure to include the invoice number. Delegations who arrive outside the official competition period, may receive two or more additional invoices. For questions or corrections please contact the organizer immediately.

Late fees:

- The payment must be received by **May 30th, 2026**.
- Entries from **May 30th, 2026**, will incur a penalty of €100 per delegation. Agreements with the organizer override the above regulations.

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20. INSURANCE AND DAMAGES

The organizers do not take any liability for injuries, accidents, diseases, or thefts. Each delegation is individually responsible for insuring all delegation members and "other/s". Please take care of your valuables- especially at the competition venue, as no liability is taken for loss, theft and /or damages.

Unfortunately, past experiences compel us to inform the delegations that participants damaging property (for example, in hotel rooms) will be held fully responsible. All damages will be invoiced directly to the team or club in the full amount.

21. VISA

Please verify as soon as possible with your travel agent or the embassy or consulate in your country if a visa is required for your travel to Berlin, Germany. The organizing committee will be happy to assist each delegation member with an official invitation letter, provided that the request is made before **May 10th, 2026**. (Please see attached form.)
